Chariton County Health Department	North Central Region	\$238,578	This grant implements an oral health education campaign and provides screenings and sealants to 2,000 students in north central Missouri. The program also offers a component to encourage youngsters to pursue dental-related professions.
Family Health Center of Boone County	North Central Region	\$306,604	This three-year grant enables the health center to increase its capacity to provide primary medical care to the medically underserved in and around Chariton County in north-central Missouri.
Marceline Community Health Center	North Central Region	\$100,000	This 2-year basic support grant provides salary funding to enable the health center to continue serving residents in north central Missouri.
Putnam County Memorial Hospital	North Central Region	\$194,182	This north central Missouri hospital is using this 2-year grant to continue providing a range of health, medical and educational services to the community.
Sullivan County Multi-Purpose Senior Center	North Central Region	\$34,885	Funding supports equipment replacement at the center, which provides meals, health screenings and education to seniors and those with disabilities living in Sullivan County.

Central Missouri Food Bank	North Central Region	\$132,980	This 12-month project enables the food bank to create a mobile food pantry which increases service reach from 52,000 people per month to 76,000 people per month.
Curators of the University of Missouri	North Central Region	\$301,938	This 3-year project expands the current mobile screening service as well as follow-up medical treatment and referrals for conditions associated with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), stroke, osteoporosis and vascular disease.
Putnam County Care Center	North Central Region	\$74,739	This grant purchases a van to provide transportation to medical appointments and a silent paging system in order to improve response time to resident calls.
Central Missouri Food Bank	North Central Region	\$132,980	This 12-month project enables the food bank to create a mobile food pantry which increases service reach from 52,000 people per month to 76,000 people per month.
