

# Want more funding to take care of Missouri kids?

The Census happens once every 10 years. If we don't count our children, nieces, nephews, and grandchildren living with us, our community will get less funding for schools, child care, and other services our children need to grow up strong. When we all respond, Missouri gets more funding for:

- Children's Health Insurance Program
- Head Start
- SNAP (also known as food stamps)

For every adult and every child that is not counted in the Census, our state will lose \$1,300 in federal dollars each year.
