Goal:

Reduce the negative health effects and economic burden of tobacco use in Missouri by supporting comprehensive tobacco control programs.



THE TOBACCO CLIMATE IN MISSOURI IN 2004:



Adult smoking prevalence – well above the national average (22.1% in 2003)



Counties with smoke-free policies



Allocated to the state tobacco prevention program



Per pack – one of the lowest state tobacco taxes in the country





MISSOURI'S SMOKING PREVALENCE DECREASED SIGNIFICANTLY AND AT A FASTER RATE THAN THE OVERALL NATIONAL DECLINE FEWER ADULT CIGARETTE SMOKERS IN 2010 COMPARED TO 2004
