

Missouri Medicaid Income Eligibility Guide for Assisters

Applicable April 1, 2023 - March 31, 2024

Medicaid expansion changed the income rules for Missouri Medicaid (MO HealthNet), which means more people qualify. The income eligibility changes every year. It is based on 138% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL). Use this chart to see if you may qualify.

Household Size	Monthly household income needs to be at or below this amount	Annual household income needs to be at or below this amount
1	\$1,677	\$20,124
2	\$2,268	\$27,216
3	\$2,859	\$34,308
4	\$3,450	\$41,400
5	\$4,042	\$48,504
6	\$4,633	\$55,596

If your household size is larger, visit the DSS link below for eligibility information.

Who to include in your household:

- Yourself
- Spouse or unmarried partner
- Children who live with you and/or anyone under 21 who lives with you
- Anyone listed on your tax return as a dependent

What to include in your household income:

- Income from you and your spouse, before taxes and deductions (also known as gross income)
- Income from any dependents who make enough money to be required to file a tax return
