**Focus Area:** After school snack program

**Amount Available:** Food, based on needs

**Restrictions/Exclusions:** Must provide organized, regularly scheduled activities in a structured and supervised environment, including an educational or enrichment activity

**Notes:** Examples of eligible activities include homework assistance, tutoring, supervised “drop-in” athletic programs, extended day programs, drama activities, and arts and crafts programs.
